Chapter 248--

An Act to amena 60.18 (.2) of the Statutes, relating to town boards exercising powers of village boards.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Sehate and Assembly, do enact as follows; 60.18 (12) of the Statutes is amened to read:

60.18 (12) To direct by resolution, the Town Board Office of Village to exercise all powers relating to villages and conferred on village boards by ch.61, except such powers, the exercise of which would conflict with the Statutes relating to towns and town boards. Any such resolution heretofore adopted pursuant to existing law or hereafter adopted pursuant to this law shall remain in force until rescinded.
