## Chapter 248--

An Act to amend 60.18 (.2) of the Statutes, relating to town boards exercising powers of village boards.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows; 60.18 (12) of the Statutes is amended to read:

60.18 (12) To direct by resolution, the Town Board Town of Stockbridge to exercise all powers relating to villages and conferred on village boards by ch.61, except such powers, the exercise of which would conflict with the Statutes relating to towns and town boards. Any such resolution heretofore adopted pursuant to existing law or hereafter adopted pursuant to this law shall remain in force until rescinded.

## RESOLUTION-----

Whereas.... Chapter 248, amending Section 60.18 (12) of the Statutes, gives towns the authority to adopt village powers at an annual or special town meeting, and

Whereas.... village powers are necessary to enforce certain laws, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this resolution be adopted this 1st day of April, 1958.
