

Town of Stockbridge (Municipality)

RESOLUTION NO. 94-05
TO CREATE AND PARTICIPATE IN THE
EAST SHORE RECYCLING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, municipalities may contract with other municipalities for the receipt or furnishings of services or the joint exercise of any power or duty required or authorized by law under sec. 66.30 of the Wisconsin Statutes;

WHEREAS, municipalities are authorized to conduct, construct, operate and maintain recycling collections and sorting facilities and operations;

WHEREAS, the Town of Stockbridge (municipality), acting for their commercial benefit and for the health, safety and welfare of their citizens, deems it to be in its best interests to enter into a cooperation agreement under sec. 66.30 of the Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of establishing the East Shore Recycling Commission for the purpose of conducting, constructing, operating and maintaining a recycling collection and sorting facility and operation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Town of Stockbridge (MUNICIPALITY) AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town of Stockbridge (municipality) does hereby enter into a contract with other municipalities pursuant to sec. 66.30 of the Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of forming the East Shore Recycling Commission.

2. The Agreement, a copy of which has been received by the Town of Stockbridge (municipality) and which creates the East Shore Recycling Commission, is hereby ratified and

approved, and the Mayor/President/Chairman and Clerk of the _____
Town of Stockbridge (municipality) is hereby authorized and
directed to enter into such Agreement.

3. _____ (Name) is hereby designated as
the representative of the Town of Stockbridge
(municipality) to the East Shore Recycling Commission with autho-
rity to exercise the powers and duties described in the Agreement
which creates the East Shore Recycling Commission. Ben
Burg (Name) is hereby designated as alternate representative
to such commission.

4 Resolution No. 94-005 introduced and its adoption moved
