

RESOLUTION

AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF STOCKBRIDGE AND  
CALUMET COUNTY FOR A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE  
DEVELOPMENT OF A  
MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL SMART GROWTH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Town of Stockbridge Board, in cooperation with Calumet County agrees to participate in the preparation of the Multi-jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan for the general purpose of guiding and accomplishing coordinated, adjusted, harmonious development within Calumet County and the Town of Stockbridge;

AND WHEREAS, the Town of Stockbridge Board, acknowledges the requirements of Wisconsin's Comprehensive Planning Legislation including the adoption of the plan (s.66.1001, Stats.), the benefits of comprehensive planning, and funding that would be awarded by the Wisconsin Department of Administration to financially assist the County and participating communities in preparation of the comprehensive plan;

AND WHEREAS, the development of the Multi-jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan requires a financial contribution of \$3600 from the Town of Stockbridge;

AND WHEREAS, a series of meetings have been recently held throughout the County by county planning staff which discussed the planning process and community responsibilities, gathered public input, provided information and answered questions relative to the planning process;

AND WHEREAS, as part of participating in the Calumet County multi-jurisdictional planning process the Town of Stockbridge will receive a County Inventory and Trends Report, an individual Land Use Element Document portraying land use for the Town of Stockbridge, and a separate County Plan Recommendations document which contains the required nine Smart Growth Comprehensive Plan elements;

AND WHEREAS, the Town of Stockbridge Board understands that if Calumet County does not receive funding from the Wisconsin Department of Administration for the Multi-jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan, the Town of Stockbridge Board is under no obligation to continue participation in the development of the Multi-jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Stockbridge Board hereby agrees to participate in the development of the Multi-jurisdictional Comprehensive Plan in cooperation with other municipalities within their county and Calumet County pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes s.66.1001.
