PROTOCOL FOR PARTICIPATING IN FIRE FIGHTER OR FIRST RESPONDER DUTIES
IF CURRENTLY ON DISABILITY

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Stockbridge Town Board that no members of the Fire Department or First Responders participate in any fire/emergency calls, rescues, accidents or training during the time in which they are on any short or long term disability. This would include being restricted to light or limited duty assignments by their physician.

Any Fire Department or First Responder member that is released from any restrictions must provide in writing, from their medical practitioner, to the Fire Chief indicating that they have the ability to perform at 100% capacity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Stockbridge Town Board that the days of credit would cease in the Wisconsin Length of Service Award Program during the time in which the Fire Fighter or First Responder is rendered disabled.
