Town of Stockbridge Monthly Town Board Minutes 7:00 p.m. Wednesday May 9, 2018 Stockbridge Community Hall

Chairman Ken Schaefer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisor Jeff Yelton, Supervisor Connie Loewe, Clerk Janene Van Hoorn, Treasurer Ralph Schmid, Calumet County Sherriff Mark Ott and approximately nineteen town residents and guests.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The Clerk verified that notices were posted.

Public Comment: Mike Lisowe voiced a concern with a culvert on Artisian Road. Lisowe feels the culvert is too small which causes water to wash out his field.

Jeff Yelton made a motion to approve the April meeting minutes as printed. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.

Discussion on an ATV/UTV Routes Ordinance. Sheriff Ott voiced concerns due to ATV/UTV's inherently being low speed vehicles made for trail and ice use, not road usage. Sheriff Ott feels they are a distraction and that ATVs and UTV's do not belong on the road. Sheriff Ott fielded questions from several people.

Town roads, equipment and buildings discussion: Ken Schaefer updated the board on road damage due to a recent storm water event. Quinney Road near the lake had major damage. The boat landing at Twilight Beach suffered damage. Quinney Fishing Club installed the boat landing and maintenance of the landing is under question. Schaefer gave an update on equipment maintenance.

Discussion of development of a manure hauling ordinance ensued. The board members will review ordinances which have been passed in other Calumet County municipalities. After reviewing the ordinances, the board members will meet to share opinions on preferred content for development of a manure hauling ordinance.

Review correspondence/communications: The clerk informed the Board that the Town has received a Recycling Grant in the amount of \$9934.16. Ken Schaefer shared that his wife fielded a call from a town resident voicing strong displeasure with the Large Item Drop Off event on May 5.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Jeff Yelton made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as presented. Seconded by Connie Loewe. Motion Carried.
