

TOWN OF STOCKBRIDGE RECYCLING GUIDELINES

WITH WHEELED RECYCLING CART: You can mix all of your recyclables and no sorting is required. Just toss all your recyclables loosely in your wheeled cart and roll it to the roadside on collection day. Be sure to place your garbage and recycling carts roadside, beginning at 5:20 a.m. and at least 3 feet between your cart and any other objects. **NO PLASTIC BAGS ALLOWED.**

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR PICKUP INCLUDE: Metal and aluminum bottles/cans, all household plastic, cartons, bottles and containers, cardboard, newspaper, magazines and junk mail, glass bottles and jars.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: No herbicide, pesticide, oil or antifreeze containers, no plastic bags, plastic film or shrink wrap, no plate glass or mirrors, no 5 gallon pails, no paint cans, no Styrofoam containers, no fluorescent bulbs, no paper with food or grease, no tissue paper or gift wrap, no aluminum pans or foil and no batteries.

BULKY TRASH ITEMS: Can be disposed of by making special pick-up appointments with GFL Services or the Town of Stockbridge Large Item Garbage Drop-off at the Town of Stockbridge Garage at N4331 Hwy 55 held on the first Saturday in May and the first Saturday in October from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Check out the website at <https://townofstockbridge.gov/garbage-recycling/> for a list of (un)acceptable items.

The ENTIRE town will be covered EVERY Friday with holiday 1 day-delay variations. Trash will NOT be picked up on the recycling day and recyclables will NOT be picked up on the trash day.
